What is decoration kids project ideas?

Decoration kids project ideas are simple, child-friendly craft concepts aimed at making decorative items: wall art, room décor, party decorations, seasonal displays, gifts, and more.

These ideas usually use low-cost materials (paper, cardboard, fabric, recycled items, paint, lights) and focus on easy steps that build creativity, fine motor skills, and pride in making something pretty and useful.

Common materials

- Colored paper, cardstock, construction paper
- Cardboard boxes, toilet-roll tubes, paper plates
- Glue, white glue, glue sticks, tape
- Scissors (child-safe), hole punch
- Paints (tempera/acrylic), brushes, markers
- Fabric scraps, ribbons, yarn, felt
- Beads, buttons, sequins, glitter (use sparingly)
- Natural items: leaves, twigs, shells, pebbles
- LED tea lights, fairy lights, battery packs
- Recycled jars, bottles, cans

150 Decoration Kids Project Ideas

Paper & Cardboard Decorations

1. **Paper Flower Bouquet** – folded paper flowers on bendy straws (materials: colored paper, glue).
2. **Paper Garland** – linked paper chains or shapes for doorways.
3. **3D Paper Stars** – fold-and-glue stars to hang from ceilings.
4. **Paper Plate Sun** – paint plate and add radiating rays.
5. **Cardboard Picture Frames** – decorate with paint, buttons, stickers.
6. **Toilet-Roll Characters** – paint tubes into cute figures for shelf décor.
7. **Cardboard City Skyline** – paint cardboard strips and mount on base as wall art.
8. **Origami Mobile** – fold cranes/hearts and hang on a stick.
9. **Paper Mosaic Art** – tear colored paper and glue into patterns.
10. **Bookmark Bunting** – decorate bookmarks and string them as mini bunting.
11. **Paper Lanterns** – cut and roll paper for soft light covers (battery tealight safe).
12. **Tassel Garland** – make paper tassels and string across a room.
13. **Accordion Paper Flowers** – layered fans glued into blooms.
14. **Puffy Paint Signs** – write kid's name in puffy paint on cardstock.
15. **Paper Doily Wall Art** – paint doilies and layer for texture.
16. **Stencil Wall Stickers** – cut shapes from removable paper.
17. **Pop-Up Card Art** – small pop-up scenes for shelf display.
18. **Cardboard Animals** – large cutouts painted as room buddies.
19. **Confetti Jars** – colorful paper confetti in jars for decoration.
20. **Paper Feather Wall Hanging** – cut feather shapes and layer.
21. **Wind Sock** – decorate a paper cylinder and add streamers.
22. **Paper Bead Garland** – roll paper beads and string them.
23. **Name Collage** – cut letters from magazines and glue on board.
24. **Patterned Paper Lampshade** – glue patterned paper to a simple shade.
25. **Mini Paper Pinwheels** – colorful desk or plant decorations.

Recycled & Upcycled Decorations

26. **Bottle Cap Magnets** – decorate caps and add magnet backs.
27. **Jar Candle Holders** – paint jars and place LED tealights.
28. **Tin Can Pencil Pots** – paint and add ribbons for desk décor.
29. **Plastic Bottle Flower Planters** – cut bottles into planters and paint.
30. **CD Reflective Mobiles** – old CDs hung to make sparkle.
31. **Magazine Roll Wall Art** – roll strips into shapes and glue on board.
32. **Shoe Box Dioramas** – themed mini scenes for shelves.
33. **Egg Carton Flowers** – paint carton cups into flower clusters.
34. **Milk Carton Birdhouse** – decorate and hang outdoors.
35. **Cork Board Art** – use wine corks to make patterns.
36. **Jar Lid Picture Frames** – small round frames painted inside.
37. **Bottle Cap Wind Chime** – string caps with beads for sound and color.
38. **Newspaper Papier-mâché Bowls** – paint for holding treasures.
39. **Fabric Scrap Wreath on Cardboard** – tie strips to a cardboard ring.

40. **Upcycled T-shirt Wall Hanging** — braided strips formed into macramé-like art.
41. **Lamp from Map/Old Book Pages** — decoupage pages onto a plain lamp.
42. **Toy Part Sculpture** — assemble old toy parts into wall art.
43. **Jar Snow Globes** — small figures glued inside with decorative filler.
44. **Bottle-cap Mosaic** — glue caps into patterns on board.
45. **Recycled Paper Beads Necklace (displayable)** — string as décor for hooks.
46. **Plastic Spoon Flower Mirror Frame** — paint spoons and glue around a mirror.
47. **Keyboard Key Art** — old keys glued in pattern for geek-chic frames.
48. **CD Suncatcher** — paint CD surface and hang in window.
49. **Map-covered Boxes** — cover storage boxes with old maps.
50. **Tin Can Lanterns** — punch holes to make patterns for light.

Fabric, Yarn & Sewing Decorations

51. **Felt Animal Garland** — cut felt animals and string them.
52. **Yarn Pom-Pom Rug (mini)** — make mini rug for dollhouse display.
53. **No-Sew T-shirt Tote** — cut and tie old T-shirt into a small tote.
54. **Button Picture Frame** — glue colorful buttons around a photo.
55. **Hand-Painted Cushion Cover** — simple stencil painting on small cushion.
56. **Miniature Fabric Bunting** — triangle bunting from fabric scraps.
57. **Sock Puppets for Shelf Stage** — decorate old socks as display characters.
58. **Fabric Scrap Flowers in a Vase** — layered fabric blooms on wire stems.
59. **Ribbon Curtain Tiebacks** — braided ribbons to decorate curtains.
60. **Yarn-wrapped Letters** — cover cardboard letters with yarn for name display.
61. **Pom-Pom Mobile** — fuzzy pom-poms hung from a hoop.
62. **Felt Coasters** — cut and glue felt shapes as table décor.
63. **Mini Quilted Wall Square** — patch some squares and hang.
64. **Embroidery Hoop Art** — simple stitching or fabric patterns in hoop.
65. **Tie-Dye Wall Hanging** — small tie-dyed cloth stretched on frame.
66. **Sew-on Patch Collage** — decorate a fabric board with patches.
67. **No-sew Fringe Wall Hanging** — layered fringes tied to a stick.
68. **Yarn Tassel Curtain** — colorful tassels hung on a rod.
69. **Friendship Bracelet Wall** — display handmade bracelets on a board.
70. **Mini Stuffed Toys as Shelf Buddies** — small sewn plushies.
71. **Fabric-Covered Jar Vases** — wrap jars with decorative fabric.
72. **Dream Pillow Sachets** — sewn small pillows with scented filling.
73. **Handprint Fabric Art** — paint handprints on fabric and frame.
74. **Macramé Plant Hanger (simple)** — basic knots for small pots.
75. **Fabric Collage Canvas** — glue cut fabric shapes into pictures.

Nature & Plant Decor

76. **Leaf Pressed Wall Art** — press leaves and arrange in frames.
77. **Pinecone Garland** — paint pinecones and string them.

78. **Pebble Name Stones** – paint names or patterns on flat pebbles.
79. **Mini Succulent Planters** – decorate small pots and plant succulents (adult help).
80. **Twig Picture Frame** – glue small twigs around a frame.
81. **Pressed Flower Bookmarks** – press flowers and laminate between paper.
82. **Shell Mosaic Tray** – glue shells to a tray base for coastal look.
83. **Acorn Cap Jewelry Dish** – small acorn cap paints for tiny decor.
84. **Nature Collage on Canvas** – glue leaves, petals, and seeds into a scene.
85. **Birdseed Ornaments** – mix birdseed and gelatin into molds for feeders.
86. **Mini Fairy Garden** – small container garden with tiny decorations.
87. **Leaf Lanterns** – glue leaves to jars for natural glow with LED.
88. **Twig Star Wall Hanging** – tie sticks into star shapes.
89. **Seed Bottle Terrarium** – small sealed plant scene in a jar (adult help).
90. **Pressed Leaf Garland** – leaves laminated on string for window.
91. **Sun-print Fabric (Cyanotype-style look)** – use safe sun-print paper (kid-safe kits).
92. **Herb Hanging Bunches** – tie herbs to hang in kitchen (supervised).
93. **Rock Photo Holders** – glue wire into painted rocks to hold photos.
94. **Flower Petal Candles (decorative—no open flame)** – arrange petals in jars around LED lights.
95. **Twig Frame with Moss Accent** – natural texture for photos.
96. **Seed Bead Nature Mobile** – beads and feathers tied with twine.
97. **Leaf Printing Canvas** – paint leaf underside and press onto canvas.
98. **Acorn Garland** – paint and string acorns as fall decor.
99. **Potted Plant Painted Rocks** – label pots with painted stones.
100. **Nature Shadow Boxes** – arrange small nature finds in a shallow box.

Painting & Mixed Media Decorations

101. **Splatter Paint Canvas** – controlled splatter for modern art.
102. **Stencil Wall Art** – stencils and paint for shapes on canvas.
103. **Canvas Collage with Found Objects** – mix paper, fabric, buttons.
104. **Glow-in-the-dark Paint Stars** – paint stars for bedroom ceilings (stick-on safe).
105. **Handprint Family Tree** – painted handprints as leaves on tree drawing.
106. **Marble-Painted Pots** – roll marbles in paint to decorate pots.
107. **Texture Paint Boards** – add sand or sawdust to paint for texture.
108. **Name Plaque with Mixed Media** – letters, beads, twine, and paint.
109. **Sponge-painted Rug Mat** – small door mat painted with sponge shapes.
110. **Silhouette Wall Art** – paint silhouettes over colorful backgrounds.
111. **Bubble Wrap Print Art** – press painted bubble wrap for pattern.
112. **Salt Dough Ornaments** – bake and paint decorative shapes.
113. **Spray Bottle Paint Canvas (outdoors)** – create patterns with spray bottles (supervised).
114. **Photo Transfer Art on Wood** – transfer printed images onto wood blocks (kid-friendly method).

- 115. **Stamped Fabric Napkins** — use potato or foam stamps to decorate fabric.
- 116. **Layered Painting with Washes** — teach simple watercolor layering.
- 117. **DIY Chalkboard Sign** — paint wood with chalkboard paint and personalize.
- 118. **Tape Resist Art** — use tape to make patterns, paint over, then remove tape.
- 119. **Decoupage Letter Boxes** — glue pictures to letters or boxes and varnish.
- 120. **Glow Jar Painting** — paint jars with glow-in-dark paint for night décor.
- 121. **Canvas Puzzle Wall** — paint across multiple small canvases to form a larger image.
- 122. **Alcohol Ink Tiles (kid-safe kit)** — bright tiles for coaster decor.
- 123. **Stencil Cushion Covers** — paint patterns onto plain cushion covers.
- 124. **Rock Painting Scenes** — tiny landscapes painted on flat stones.
- 125. **Mixed Media Dreamboard** — combine photos, paint, fabric, and words.

Lights & Tech-lite Decorations

- 126. **Fairy-Light Bottle Lamp** — string lights into a painted bottle.
- 127. **Glow Jar Nightlight** — LED lights inside decorated jars.
- 128. **Light-up Paper Lanterns** — paper lanterns with battery lights.
- 129. **String Light Photo Display** — clip photos to lit string lights.
- 130. **Luminous Wall Canvas** — paint with glow-in-the-dark paints for a night effect.
- 131. **LED Mason Jar Centerpiece** — jar filled with fairy lights and decor.
- 132. **Shadow Box with Backlight** — silhouette cut-outs with LED strip behind.
- 133. **Mini Light-Up Signs (battery LEDs)** — spell names with LED rope lights on board (adult help with wiring-free LEDs).
- 134. **Bottle Cap LED Garland** — small LED lights placed in bottle caps for a cute string.
- 135. **Glow-in-the-dark Pebble Path (indoor)** — arrange glow pebbles as a decorative trail (not for walking).
- 136. **Lighted Paper Trees** — paper trees wrapped with thin fairy lights.
- 137. ** LED Origami Lamps (battery)** — origami shape around battery light.
- 138. **Night-sky Projector Craft (cardboard tube)** — cut stars and use a battery LED to project (supervised).
- 139. **Photo Cube Light Box** — transparent cube with photos and small LED inside.
- 140. **Circuit Sticker Greeting Board (simple)** — use sticker circuits to light up parts of an art board (kid-friendly kits).

Holiday & Seasonal Decorations

- 141. **Paper Easter Egg Garland** — colorful cut-out eggs strung together.
- 142. **Pumpkin Painted Jars (fall)** — paint jars like pumpkins for autumn décor.
- 143. **Winter Snowflake Window Art** — cut paper snowflakes and stick to windows.
- 144. **Valentine Heart Wreath** — paper or fabric hearts tied to a ring.
- 145. **Diwali Tea Light Holders** — decorate small jars for LED diyas.
- 146. **Halloween Mask Wall Display** — create spooky masks and hang on wall.
- 147. **Fourth of July Star Bunting** — star shapes in red/white/blue stringed together.
- 148. **Spring Flower Crown Display** — make crowns and hang on pegs as decoration.

- 149. **Thanksgiving Gratitude Tree** — paper leaves with thankful notes on a branch.
- 150. **New Year Glitter Jar** — glitter and confetti in a jar as a festive table piece (no open flame).

Quick Project Tips & Variations

- Encourage color themes (pastel, rainbow, monochrome).
- Upcycle materials first — teach sustainability.
- Let kids add personal touches: names, photos, favorite colors.
- For school displays, add a short card with project name, child's name, and materials used.
- Use LED lights instead of candles for safe glowing effects.

How to display finished projects

- Create a rotating “Artist Wall” with clips or corkboard.
- Use clear jars or glass shelves for 3D items.
- Make small tags explaining materials and age group.
- Host a mini exhibition at home/school and invite family.


